To be considered for presentation, please adhere to the below guidelines for your abstract submissions.

Category 1: Research/Scientific Abstracts (Max 400 words)

- Abstract Title
- Abstract Author(s) with Degrees (please bold presenting author)
- Submitting Institution
- Abstract Body
 - An English language abstract must be in the terminology familiar to specialists.
 - The text should be succinct and substantive.

The abstract must include the following 5 sections:

- (a) Introduction
- (b) Methods
- (c) Results
- (d) Conclusion
- (e) Significance

Category 2: Other Abstracts (Max 200 words)

Other abstracts may include case reports, surgical techniques, and emerging ideas or technology.

- Abstract Title
- Abstract Author(s) with Degrees (please bold presenting author)
- Submitting Institution
- Abstract Body
 - An English language abstract must be in the terminology familiar to specialists.
 - The text should be succinct and substantive.
 - The abstract must include the following 2 sections:
 - (a) Description (of the proposed presentation including details regarding the case, case series, surgical technique or emerging ideas)
 - (b) Significance

Tables, Graphs and Images: You may submit up to two associated charts/tables or figures/graphics embedded in the Word Doc. The total file size should be no more than 5MB.
